PERFORMER AGREEMENT MENOTOMY MUSICAL THEATER

As a member of the cast you agree that you are old enough to accept a certain level of responsibility, therefore, you have read and understand the conditions below and agree to abide by the rules set forth.

- You agree to attend all rehearsals for which you are scheduled. If you must miss a rehearsal for any reason, it must be submitted in writing prior to the auditions.
- If you have more than two unexcused absences, you understand that you will will be at risk of being cut from some scenes and musical numbers or being dismissed from the show entirely.
- You understand that you are part of a team effort, so you must have a positive attitude, work collaboratively with cast mates and be respectful of the staff and peers. If you violate any of the behavior guidelines you understand that you are at risk of being dismissed from the show.
- You agree to be flexible. There will be times when there will be changes in scenes, blocking, music and choreography. You agree and understand that this is part of the process.
- When not onstage you understand that your only options are to read a book, read the script or watch the rehearsal. Cell phones are NOT Allowed at rehearsals. You understand that excessive talking and goofing around is not permitted.
- You understand that you cannot leave the rehearsal area for any reason unless you have permission from the producer, director, stage manager or choreographer.
- You understand that you are expected to clean up after yourself at the end of rehearsal including picking up trash and accounting for all personal items including scripts.
